Aunt Ruby's German Green

Heirloom - Indeterminate (Vine) 80 to 85 days to maturity from transplant



A really nice beefsteak-type tomato with fruit are five inches in diameter by four inches deep, weigh one pound or more and remain green coloured at maturity. Sweet juicy flesh, refreshing spicy flavour.

This family heirloom was introduced to the general public by Ruby E. Arnold (1915-1997) of Greeneville, Tennessee. According to the family, they are not sure how, when or why the "German" got added to the name of this variety. They are not from Germany and they have no known German ancestry. They speculate that Ruby's may have selected her tomato from a now unknown variety from seed originally sourced from a German-speaking Amish seedsman in their area named Ivan Snapp.

Banana Legs

Determinate (Bush)

75 days to maturity from transplant



Banana Legs are a vigorous growing, determinate tomato. They are extremely prolific, producing heavy yields of 5-10 cm (2-4") long fruits that ripen to a golden yellow. Very meaty, sweet flesh with very few seeds. A pleasant tasting flavour that starts out quite mild at the beginning of the season and becomes richer later in the season.

Plants become a sprawling bush and should be staked or caged to help contain vigorous growth.

Fun to grow and perfect for brightening up salads.

Barry's Crazy Cherry

Indeterminate (Vine)

75 days to maturity from transplant



Pale yellow cherries are delicious, and grow on some of the largest clusters known! Sweet fruit is oval, each with a tiny "beak" at the blossom end. Flavour is good, the fruit keeps well, and the sight of the 20- to 40-fruit trusses on the large plants is positively mind-boggling.

Beefsteak

Heirloom. Indeterminate (vine)

60 to 80 days to maturity from transplant



This indeterminate tomato (individual fruits ripen successively over many days) remains our most popular main season tomato - mostly because of its consistent performance and heavy yields! Large solid fruits weighing up to 260g (9oz) are a rich red colour. It's important to irrigate frequently so the plants never wilt.

Days to harvest are highly variable depending on growing condition.

Black Cherry

Heirloom. Indeterminate (vine)

65 days to maturity after transplanting




Black Cherry tomato produces hardy, vigorous vines loaded with gorgeous purple to mahogany brown cherry tomatoes 2.5 cm (1") round. Enjoy prolific yields all season long! Rich, juicy cherry tomatoes with wonderfully complex, sweet flavour and firm texture. The little fruits of this variety look exotic and taste irresistibly delicious. A great snacking tomato, excellent in bruschetta.

Vines typically grow at least 150 cm (60") and require caging or staking for support. For best results, allow these cheery tomatoes to ripen on the vine, and harvest regularly. Fruits are ripe when they turn olive/eggplant in colour and they pop readily off the stem with a roll of the fingers.

Black Krim

Heirloom. Indeterminate (vine)

75 days to maturity from transplant



Black Krim Organic are a favourite of gourmet chefs, this unique heirloom tomato consistently wins top place and receives rave reviews at taste trials. The fruits are extremely juicy with incredibly complex sweet, smoky flavours and a hint of saltiness.

Drizzle with olive oil and sprinkle of sea salt for a zesty snack. Also great sliced with fresh mozzarella, basil, and drizzled with olive oil and balsamic vinegar.

The fruits mature late and are prolific producers of large fruit 227 - 283 grams (8-12 oz.). Typically they range from dark purple to mahogany skin with green shoulders and green tinted flesh.

Originally from the town of Krymysk near the Black Sea, Black Krim plants that are exceptionally hardy. Naturally disease resistant, the plants adapt well to adverse conditions in a wide range of climates.

Healthy, attractive vines reach 1.8 metres (6') or more and require heavy staking or caging to support excellent yields of large, heavy fruit.

Black Opal

Indeterminate (Vine)

70 Days to maturity from transplant



Bred from the popular heirloom Black Cherry and selected specifically for its improved growth habit, firmer texture and superior flavour. Masses of 1/2" round fruits are excellent for fresh eating, grilling or sauces and pastes.

Extremely productive.

Brown Sugar Heirloom - Indeterminate (Vine)95 days to maturity



A Russian heirloom, also known as Korichnevyi Sakhar, with silky texture and a smoky, complex flavour. Black tomatoes are famous for their rich, nuanced flavour, and the 7-oz., globe-shaped fruit of Brown Sugar does not disappoint.

This is a gourmet, sugar-sweet tomato, just perfect for snacking, slicing, cooked dishes, and sauces.

Grows to about 200 cm in height and spreads somewhat the same in width, so requires staking and pruning. Great cold tolerance.

Celebrity Hybrid

Determinate (Bush)

75 days to maturity



This AAS Winner is a favourite for yield and garden performance. A hardy, adaptable tomato. Grow as a bush, cage or short staking tomato. Look for nicely shaped, large 280 g (10 oz) fruit with firm, flavourful flesh. Grows 60-80 cm in height.

Large yields. Resistance: V, F, N, TMV, ASC, ST. Harvest in approximately 75 days. Days to harvest are highly variable depending on growing conditions. Determinate growth pattern.

Even inexperienced tomato growers may find this variety to be relatively trouble free. It's resistant to many pests and diseases, and has a robust growth habit. It also can be grown easily in containers, Use a large container that's at least five gallons, to give your plants plenty of root space, and make sure the container has good drainage

Resistant to Verticilium Wilt, Fusarium, Roots Nematodes, Tobacco Mosaic Virus and Alternaria Stem Canker and Stemphylium

Chocolate Cherry

Heirloom - Indeterminate 65 days to maturity



Chocolate Cherry tomatoes are a unique heirloom that have a deep colour and complex flavour. 1-2 oz attractive brownish-red fruit is sweet & juicy with a refreshing flavour. Prolific 6-8' tall slender vines hold large trusses of seemingly endless fruit that will keep producing until the frost.

Prune and trellis for ideal plant health and maximum fruit production.

Early Girl

Indeterminate (vine)

57 days to maturity from transplant



Choose Early Girl tomato for a fast and early crop of delicious medium-sized red tomatoes. This is an early maturing variety for coastal grower. The plants keep bearing fruit heavily throughout the summer on manageable, disease resistant vines, producing baskets of tasty, 110-170g 4-6 oz) tomatoes. Early Girl is resistant to Fusarium wilt races 1 and 2.

Some coastal growers choose early maturing tomatoes as a way to beat Late Blight. The disease usually strikes mid- to late summer, and by that time Early Girl has already produced the bulk of her fruit.

Goldkrone Indeterminate (Vine) 90 to 100 days to maturity



'Goldkrone' produces and abundance of tasty, sweet and nutritious cherry tomatoes in summer. Suitable for growing outdoors in a sheltered sunny spot, or in a greenhouse to achieve a longer cropping season. A reliable and great-tasting variety, ideal for adding to salads, sandwiches, home-made salsa, sauces or snacking.

Moneymaker Heirloom. Indeterminate (vine)

75 - 80 days to maturity from transplant



This old English heirloom variety came from Bristol, circa the early 1900's. Originally bred for greenhouses, it can be successfully grown in any garden. Though Moneymaker plants do prefer high heat, the plants are amazingly adaptable and will set fruit freely in any weather. Best controlled by staking and pruning.

Moneymaker Organic tomatoes are vigorous plants 1.5 -1.8 m (5-6') tall. Enjoy continuous heavy yields of deep red coloured globes in clusters of 6 to 10 fruit. The uniform, smooth- skinned fruit are medium in size averaging 113-170 gram (4-6 oz.). Fruits are juicy with classic taste and a sweet bite.

This is a medium-early, main season tomato.

Oregon Spring Determinate (bush)

75 days to maturity from transplant



Oregon Spring Organic tomato seeds produce the early tomato of choice for growers in cold, wet climates or anywhere with a short growing season. This variety is resistant to Verticillium Wilt.

The compact, tidy bush is resilient and will produce luscious medium large fruit, about 170-200 gram (6-7 oz.). Fruits have a mild, sweet flavour and remain nearly seedless until the end of summer.

Developed Dr. James Baggett with Oregon State University, Oregon Spring Organic are renowned for their early yields and remarkable ability to set easily in cool weather. These determinate (bush) plants are parthenocarpic - forming fruit without pollination.

Patio Determinate - Bush 70 days



A perfect tomato for container gardening. The bushy, miniature plants are loaded with dark red, 115 g (4 oz) medium size fruit. Grows 60-80 cm in height.

Harvest in approximately 70 days. Days to harvest are highly variable depending on growing conditions.

Resistance to Alternaria Stem Canker and Stemphylium.

Pink Fang Indeterminate (Vine) 80 to 85 days to maturity



This exotic looking beauty has the best taste of any paste tomato we have tried. The flavour of this big paste tomato will put a regular Roma to shame! Incredibly flavourful and so sweet! The super-long, 6-inch fruit of this paste tomato has very few seeds and thick, sweet flesh. Try making this meaty, sweet variety into paste or marinara.

Pink Ponderosa

Heirloom - Indeterminate (Vine)

85 days to maturity



Introduced by Peter Henderson Seed Company in 1891, Ponderosa Pink, or Henderson's Pink, has become one of the most appreciated beefsteak-style tomatoes. Pink Ponderosa produces tomatoes that are slightly ribbed at the shoulders, flattened, and round. Juicy flesh with a sweet flavour. Fruits are low in acid. The giant fruits can weight up to 2 pounds each and the flesh is meaty, thick, sweet and almost seedless. Ponderosa Pink is a good candidate for "one-slice" tomato sandwiches and for canning

The indeterminate-growing plants bears loads of extra-large tomatoes of a light red with a pink blush.

Principe Borghese

Heirloom - Semi-determinate (Vine)

70 to 75 days to maturity



Clusters of sumptuous, meaty cherry-sized fruits appear in one main set on tall plants that benefit from support. This Tuscan heirloom is one of the finest for sun-dried tomatoes, but the fruits also can particularly well.

Try growing some in three to five gallon pots on the balcony, or up against the south facing wall of a house to maximize heat from the sun. This will produce more fruits with better consistent fruit set.

The semi-determinate vines benefit from support.

Pruden's Purple

Heirloom - Indeterminate (Vine)

80 to 85 days to maturity



Early heirloom potato leafed beefsteak. This early heirloom indeterminate beefsteak tomato that can reach up to 450g has meaty purple-pink flesh. It has a flattened top with smooth slightly ribbed skin that resists cracks and a unique potato leaf shape that sets it apart from other varieties.

Indeterminate plants are tall, require staking and produce tomatoes over a longer period of time. Instead of having one large harvest at once, they bear over a period of months.

These are perfect for home gardeners who want their harvest spread out, or greenhouse growers that want tall plants to best use their space.

Rainbow Indeterminate - Vine 82 days to maturity



This is a large, yellow and red marbled eye catching tomato has large fruit that matures to a beautiful golden yellow striped with red. As fruits ripen they have a rainbow appearance: greens on the shoulder, yellow, orange and gold in the middle, and red on the blossom end with a swirl of colour inside too

Beefsteak type fruit weighs up to 900 g (2 lb). Taste is rich, sweet and juicy.

Smooth delicious, juicy and fruity flavour. It will become a favourite if you don't already know it. Great for slicing and eating fresh.

A medium tall vine that will need to be staked.

Red Zebra Indeterminate (vine) 93 days to maturity from transplant



Red Zebra tomatoes have a unique striped bi-coloured outer skin that is overall cherry-red in color with light yellow-orange streaks. They are round and uniform in shape, and they grow to be about two to three inches when matured. The inner flesh of the Red Zebra is darker red in color and is very juicy, offering a mild acidity and a delicious sweet-tart tomato flavour.

Red Zebra tomatoes are extremely flavourful and can be used for fresh eating, roasting, making sauces, or even canning. With their round uniform shape, Red Zebra tomatoes are perfect for skewering onto kebabs or serving halved in salads. Their vibrant color will showcase well in pico de gallo and bruschetta, or atop pizzas and pasta.

Rose De Berne Heirloom. Indeterminate (vine) 75 days days to maturity from transplant



Rose de Berne is a Swiss heirloom whose lovely name describes this very beautiful dark pink tomato that is shaped like a perfect globe, smooth and round with no blemishes.

Fruits are medium size, 6 to 8 ozs., and boast flavour that is as impressive as its pretty appearance. These tomatoes have a thin skin, are juicy, and filled with sweet flavour that is wonderfully balanced with a bit of zing.

Very productive plants yield a heavy crop.

San Marzano Heirloom - Indeterminate (Vine) 85 days to maturity



Native to Italy, San Marzano tomatoes can be identified easily by their oblong shape and pointed ends. Sometimes they are called "San Marzano sauce tomatoes," because they are fleshy and have fewer seeds than other kinds of tomatoes. Strong and sweet in flavour and less acidic, this old-fashioned tomato is a favorite snack of many gardeners. Fruits grow in clusters of 6 to 8, each about 4 inches long.

San Marzanos vines can reach 6 to 8 feet tall.

Super Italian Paste - Roma

Heirloom - Indeterminate (Vine)



Super Italian Paste tomato is an Italian heirloom paste tomato which produces an abundant amount of reddish orange, 15 cm (6"), elongated, firm tomatoes that average about 283 g (10 ounce) each. The flesh is thick with very little juice and few seeds. These fruits hold well after ripening.

Vines will required staking and tying to maximize growth and higher yields. Grows to approximately 1.5m (5') tall.

Sweet Million

Indeterminate (vine)

60 to 65 days to maturity from transplant



Sweet Million cherry tomato seeds are easy to grow, and hardy plants adapt well to many climates. Tall vigorous vines grow masses of gorgeous red cherry tomatoes on long trusses. This variety is the winner of the Royal Horticultural Society (RHS) Award of Garden Merit. Sweet Million tomato plants mature early and deliver incredible yields of delicious sweet cherry tomatoes all season long. A terrific snacking tomato that's impossible to resist!

This extremely vigorous plant needs support for climbing habit, pruning may be required for containment in smaller areas. Uniform fruits are 2.5 cm (1") average 10-15 grams (~1/2 oz.).

Sweet Million tomatoes are resistant to, or tolerant of, Fusarium Wilt (Race 1), Tomato (Tobacco) Mosaic Virus.

Sweetheart

Indeterminate (Vine)

65-70 days to maturity from transplant.




Sure to win any gardener's heart. A bright red grape tomato that will give you masses of extra-sweet and crack resistant heart-shaped 1.5" fruit, borne in long clusters, making harvesting very easy. This hybrid is very vigorous and requires support. Give your salads a delicious touch of sweet freshness.

Indeterminate plants are tall, require staking and produce tomatoes over a longer period of time. Instead of having one large harvest at once, they bear over a period of months. These are perfect for home gardeners who want their harvest spread out, or greenhouse growers that want tall plants to best use their space.

Sweetie Indeterminate (vine)

50 - 80 days to maturity from transplant



Sweetie cherry tomatoes are highly adaptable to adverse growing conditions and plants are well tolerant of cool, wet conditions. A winner in flavour among the early red cherry varieties, they have a unique, rich, sweet flavour and can be used for juice and preserves without adding sugar. Sweetie cherry tomatoes average 12-14% sugar content!

Vigorous, indeterminate vines reach 1.8 meters (6') long and require staking. Highly productive, with a long harvest window, the plants bear generous clusters of 15-20 juicy cherry tomatoes 2.5-3.8 cm (1-1.5") until the first frost.

For best results, harvest fruit when fully coloured and firm. About one month before the average first fall frost, clip all blossoms and any undersized fruit off the plant. This will steer all the plants remaining energy into ripening what's left. If you have a lot of under ripe tomatoes near the end of the season, and a frost is approaching, pick them and store them indoors. Plants are naturally resistant to Alternaria Stem Canker (ASC).

TigerellaHeirloom - Indeterminate (Vine)



The Tigerella tomato is a English heirloom that grows tangy, bite sized fruits that are red with orange stripes. Perfectly round fruits reach 2" in diameter. Enjoy this variety right off the vine or thrown into your favorite salad. Expect large yields!

It is more cold hardy than other varieties and thrives in humid summers.

Disease resistant and grows well in greenhouses.

Yellow Pear Shaped

Heirloom - Indeterminate (Vine)

80 days to maturity



The Yellow Pear tomato is one of the older small fruit types, first developed in Europe in 1805. The 2 m tall plants produce masses of 1 1/2 to 2 inch, pear-shaped, lemon coloured fruits. This reliable, indeterminate, heirloom tomato adds flavour and color to your culinary efforts all season long. With few seeds and mild (low-acid) flavour, they are also delicious eaten right off the vine
